... As global warming pushes temperatures up and droughts become more intense, the production of maize, southern Africa's staple food, could drop by as much as 30 percent in another two decades... Investments aimed at improving agricultural adaptation to climate change will inevitably favor some crops and regions over others. The particular crops identified, however, depend on criteria that will vary for different institutions according to their capabilities, goals, and risk attitudes...
